

Elizabeth Perkins "Sow" won the Best in Show award last year and a solo show this year. Perkins was born and raised in a rural farming community. After earning a BFA in sculpture from the Atlanta College of Art and studying glass at the California College of Arts and Crafts, she returned to the Jamestown Glasshouse to study as an apprentice.

Statement: My work is the recollections and reinterpretations of memories formed at the family farm in Louisa County, Virginia. My work deals with southern mystique, family traditions and the stories that have been passed down from three

generations of hardworking and loving "farming-

folk". In my work, the material and subject matter preserve and show the deterioration of what is being forgotten and what has been worked so hard for. Fragility and strength are present in the work and speak as metaphor for what is handed down and what should or should not be passed on.




Rene Culler Juror
